## Certificate III in Bricklaying/Blocklaying (Apprenticeship) CPC30108

Berwick TEC offers you the opportunity to move straight into a full-time apprenticeship in Certificate III in Bricklaying and Blocklaying. This is a trade level qualification for apprentices and you will need a "Contract of Training" with an employer. Your employer will then register you with Berwick TEC for your schooling.

With an apprenticeship, you learn industry specific skills by working and training on the job. Berwick TEC is a great alternative to do an apprenticeship as often assessment is performed at your workplace to make things easier for you and your employer.

A feature of the Certificate III in Bricklaying/Blocklaying is that your training takes place in Berwick TEC's unique simulated Building Site. This work space simulates the operations of a live building site where several trades can work around each other, or together on common projects.

### **Mature Aged Entry**

Mature aged students are encouraged to apply. This may include those who have been working in the industry for a number of years without a qualification in bricklaying. This may include applications for **RPL** (recognition of prior learning and skills).

### **Enrolment**

This is ongoing throughout the year (**rolling** enrolments).

### **How to apply - Entry Requirements**

It is recommended that you have at least a year 10 level of education or equivalent.

You must have entered into a 'Contract of Training' with your employer and be employed as an apprentice. You may also want to contact us regarding group training organisations and contacts if you are looking for an employer.
